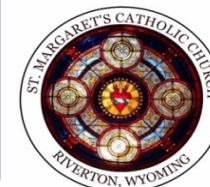

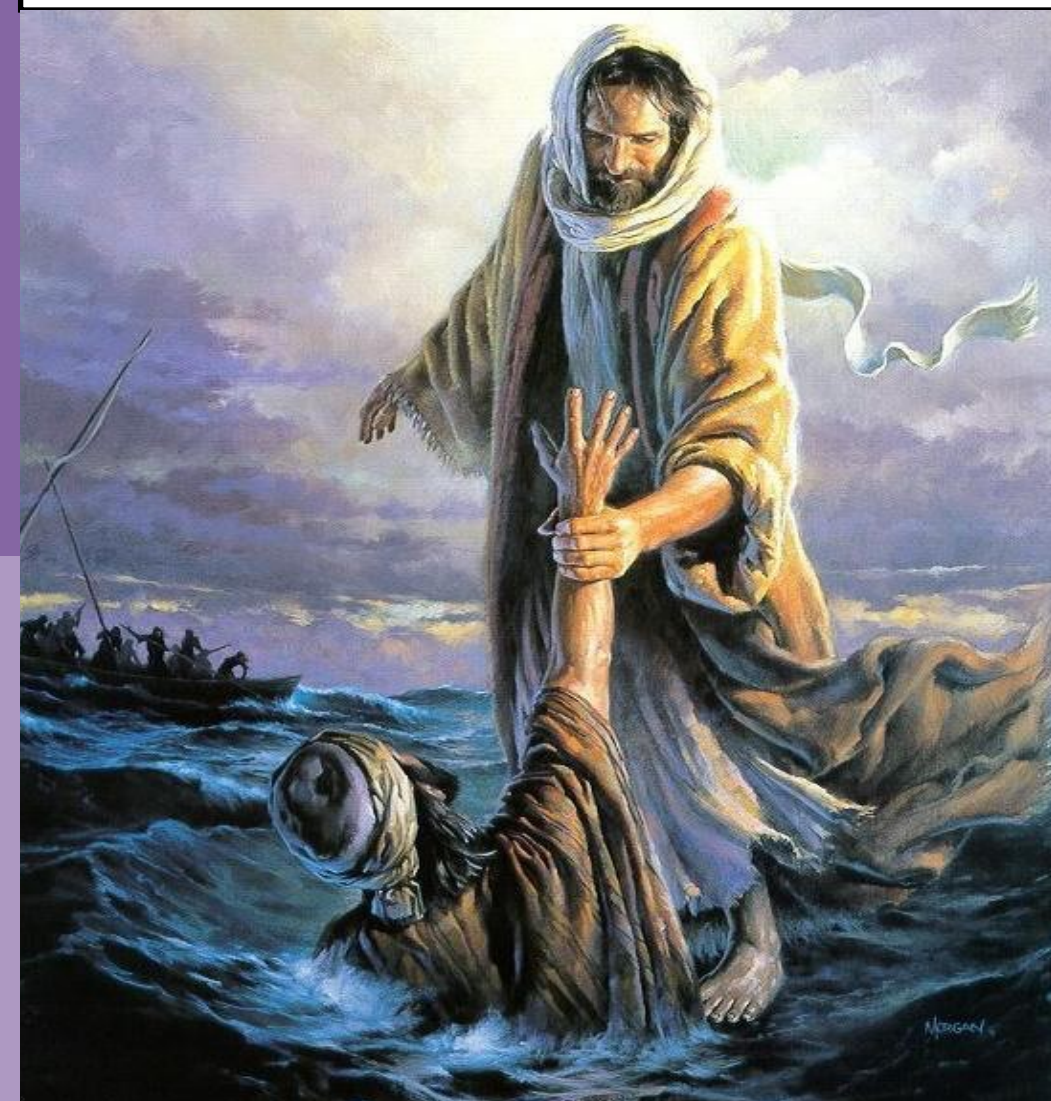

“Oh you of little faith! Why did you doubt?” Who among us has not had to answer this question? We have doubts. It is who we are. Doubts are part of our lives. Doubts invade our faith all of the time. Let’s think about what the Lord is saying to Peter here. He reaches out to him and helps him. He is teaching him not condemning him. Let’s look at what is going on with Peter. He starts to sink when he notices the wind, really when he takes his attention away from Jesus. How easy it is to doubt when we allow ourselves to wander away from Jesus. “Man will not consent to drive away the money-changers from the temple of his soul until he realizes that it is a Holy of Holies—not a house of traffic, but in very truth the house of God.
