



I want to give a little insight into what St. Margaret's School students are like. At the beginning of the school-wide Penny Ninja game, staff reminded students at morning prayer about the three pillars of Lent. We briefly discussed the spirit with which we hope all students approach Penny Ninja. We focus on almsgiving and charity as the purpose, and we fast from distractions like arguments and too much competition over winning. It was a simple reminder. If I'm being honest, I half expected to address a few instances of angry tears, but I knew Penny Ninja would be engaging, and those tough experiences would still be good learning experiences if handled the right way.

But I was wrong. These kids didn't trifle with arguments at all. All we heard was laughter in the hallways during "slashing" time, when they put silver coins (worth negative points) in the jars outside other classroom doors. I heard students at least three times say something like, "Preschool is winning, but we all win because we're helping people who need it!"

Preschool did end up with the highest profit, but the whole school won. They raised over \$1,800 for Eagle's Hope Transitions. With spare change.


These incredible children are the products of their teachers, paras, lunch lady, secretary, and, most of all, their parents. Thank you for instilling in them this joyful spirit of service.

Roland "Nick" Eckes 4th Degree Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to students working towards an under graduate degree. All graduating seniors and above along with vocational, and seminariary will be eligible. No graduate school students may apply. One scholarship will be available this year in the amount of \$500.00. Donations from any other source will be accepted and added to increase this amount, the final amount may vary. The Faithful Navigator will appoint the scholarship committee. It will be composed of 4th degree Knights of the Father Adolph Pate Assembly #1291. The faithful navigator is automatically a member of the committee.

A G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher along with financial need will be the basic criteria considered.
