Fr. Eugene's Corner

We are still in the season of Easter and rejoicing in the risen Lord. Just last Sunday, we saw Jesus declare "I am the good Shepherd" (John 10:11). In today's gospel, Jesus declared "I am the Vine" (John 15:1). The use of this image of the Vine is a symbolic representation of the people of Israel. In the Old Testament, the vine represented the people of Israel, planted from selected stock, cared for by the Lord, that they may produce the fruits of Justice (Isa. 5:1-7). Now, Jesus is the true Vine. He is the trunk of the tree from which the branches sprout; that is to say, all of us are like branches united to him and who live by him. But he is also the entire plant, trunk, and branches together; the community of Christians is really the body of Christ.

A critical look at this gospel leads us to understand the importance of relationship and interdependence. Jesus wants Christians to be united to him, lest we be cut off. This connotes that separation from the Lord is not advised. We are encouraged to abide, relate, and depend on Jesus for life, grace, sustenance, and peace. He says, "I am the Vine" (John 15:1). He further affirmed, "I am the vine, and you are the branches" (John 15:5). Interestingly, if we genuinely abide in Christ, we will bear fruits to the glory of God and for our well-being. Abiding in Jesus demands a daily life of prayer and daily reading of the Bible. God's word has the capacity to prune, purify, and bless us. Jesus is the Word made flesh (John 1:1). May God's grace and word abide with us always. Amen!
