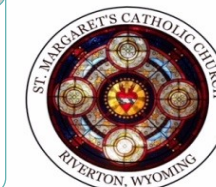

Fr. Louis' Corner

We hear in our gospel reading from John this week of Jesus telling the disciples to remain in His love. He then tells them that the way to do that is to obey His commandments. As he continues to teach them he tells them that what he is commanding them is to love one another. In our first reading from the Acts of the Apostles we hear of Peter's trip from Joppa to Caesarea to visit the centurion Cornelius. Angels have intervened to help Peter understand that the salvation of Jesus Christ is for all and not just for the Jews. When Peter had heard Jesus command that the disciples love one another he may well have not understood the scope of the commandment. But now he must realize that when Jesus told them to love one another that He was not just talking about loving the other disciples or other Jews, but quite literally everyone. We are all called to be disciples and called to inspire others to be disciples of Jesus so that the love of God can encompass the whole world.


Faith Formation News

Ordination of Lee Noel

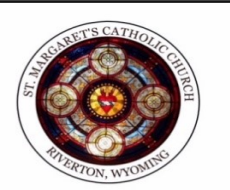
