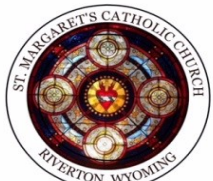

Today, I want to follow up on what I wrote last week addressing the topic of freedom. You see, our current culture is full of false promises, and too often we buy in to them. When we do that, we buy in to a sort of hologram, some-thing that might look or sound real, but isn’t. So here’s a question for you: Judging by your lifestyle, would you say that you are captivated by illusionary holograms or by a vision of the eternal? Can you be truly free while being a slave to worldly values, applying worldly values to matters of faith, or are you emancipated and free by being a slave of Christ? It’s a paradox! But just take the values of the current culture, turn them upside down, and you may well have more of a Biblical world-view, a Biblical guarantee of emancipation. Live not in a hologram, but in God’s World and in God’s Word - - - and you will be free. You will know emancipation.
