



We being our liturgy or the Word this week hearing of Elisha feeding 100 people with 20 barley loaves. These loaves would have been a serving for one person, so we know that this is a miraculous work of God through the prophet. Then in the Gospel we hear of the feeding of the 5 thousand men (plus all of the women and children that were there also) so this is a much grander miracle. After sating the hunger of the crowd Jesus desires to build their hunger for the true food of redemption that He brings us. The crowd however has other ideas and dream of Jesus defeating the Romans. Jesus withdraws to the mountain to avoid them carrying him off to be their earthly king. What Jesus desires for us is what St Paul tells us in our second reading; that we abide in Jesus’ peace with unity and hope.

Faith Formation News

As July draws to a close, I am drawn to the first two commandments. Specifically, I’m thinking about the name of God. You see, as human beings, we don’t name ourselves. Our names are given to us, they are not chosen. The act of naming is an act of authority. By contrast, no one named God. I don’t tell God who God is, God tells me. Our first two Command-ments defend the honor of God’s name. God refers to Himself in the 3<sup>rd</sup> person, which calls attention to God’s covenant name: Yahweh or Lord. God revealed His name at Sinai (Ex. 3:14-15). The Jewish people of Old Testament times felt that God’s name could not even be spoken, since it was so holy. Thus we have what is called the *Tetragrammaton* (4 letters (YHWH or JHWH). This is how God’s name is used in the Old Testament. How do you use God’s name?


