



Fr. Louis' Corner

Jesus is the bread of life; the living bread that came down from heaven. He teaches this in the synagogue of Capernaum evoking differing responses from those who hear him. Many leaders of the Jews are angry and baffled that he say that they need to eat his flesh. And drink his

blood? Drinking blood from any animal is expressly forbidden, let alone from a human! They are so busy trying to find ways to discredit him that they are completely missing the point. It is his very being that he wants to share with us. We have to decide for ourselves if we are going to accept this gift: the Eucharist. More importantly how our we going to accept this gift? Is it something that we take for granted? As if it were something that we do because of social obligation. Jesus calls us to allow the Eucharist to transform our lives, to help us to recognize Him in all others. When we allow the Eucharist to work in us, the grace of Jesus fills us with his love and peace.

Faith Formation News

As we continue through the "dog days of August," here is a reading from Sacred Scripture that I believe should speak to all of us who desire to live lives that are more and more pleasing to God. It comes from Romans 12: 1-2. "Think of God's mercy, my brothers, and worship him, I beg you, in a way that is worthy of thinking beings, by offering your living bodies as a holy sacrifice, truly pleasing to God. Do not model yourselves on the behavior of the world around you, but let your behavior change, modeled by your new mind. This is the only way to discover the will of God and know what is good, what it is that God wants, what is the perfect thing to do." The "new mind" reminds me of the Greek word for repentance: metanoia, which means literally to change your mind. That sounds like a good formula for continuing faith formation!
