Fr. Eugene's Corner

Just last Sunday, we learned about ginōskō, eidō and epiginōskō, the three levels of knowing God. Today, we proceed further into a statement of faith expressed by Peter in the Gospel: "Lord, to whom shall we go?" Peter leads us

deeper into expressing and putting into practice our deeper knowledge of God. "To whom shall we go?" is an expression of readiness to act. We are called to put this conviction of the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist into practice. Let me illustrate with a story. A story was told of a Catholic woman who came to Mass and received Holy Communion. Before she approached the priest for Communion, she silently prayed in her heart for healing from a stomach pain. Immediately after receiving the Holy Communion, as she walked back to her seat, she was

healed of the pain. Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist. Lord, we come to You today and always. Kindly strengthen our faith in You more and more. Amen.
