Wyoming's Education Savings Account (ESA) provides \$6,000 annually for students enrolled in private and home schools to support their educational expenses. Any Wyoming resident ages four and above and in pre-k through grade 12 with a household income below 150% of the federal poverty guidelines (approximately \$46,800 for a family of four) qualifies for this support.

Fr. Eugene’s Corner

The Positive Use of Riches

It is said that riches are blessings from God, and clearly, God loves a cheerful giver. It is evident that God does not forbid the possession of riches. In the Gospel we read, Jesus does not condemn the possession of wealth; rather, it is the wise and generous use of riches that is encouraged. God wants us to support His Church and humanity with our wealth. In fact, it is God who gives the power to make wealth (Deuteronomy 8:17-18). In 3 John 1:2, the Scriptures say, “How I wish that you may prosper and be in good health, even as your soul prospers.” In the Bible, there are many examples of rich people who were friends of God. Abraham (Genesis 13:1-2) was a friend of God and a wealthy man. Isaac (Genesis 26:13-15) was rich, and Job (Job 1:3-6) was also well-to-do. In 1 Chronicles 29:28-30, David is described as wealthy, and in 1 Kings 10:14-25, King Solomon was also rich. Furthermore, in the Gospel of Luke 8:2-3, Mary Magdalene and Joanna provided material support for the ministry of Jesus. In all of these examples, the Scriptures admonish us to give to the work of God and to help our brothers and sisters in need. God loves a cheerful giver (2 Corinthians 9:7). Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, we are encouraged to use our riches for the glory of God and for the good of humanity.

As the General Assembly of the Bishops on the Synod on Synodality is held in Rome throughout the month of October, Pope Francis invites us to pray for a shared mission that sustains in all ways a Synodal lifestyle, as a sign of co-responsibility, promoting the participation, the communion, and the mission shared among priests, religious, and lay people.

I’m musing today on some of the writings of Saint. Augustine. Most famous for writing about a "city on a hill," he was also good at writing what I call epigrams. Here are two of them: "Pray as though everything depended upon God; Work as though everything depended upon you." And then there’s this gem: "Charity is no substitute for justice withheld." That last quote reminds me of words spoken by Abraham Lincoln during his second inaugural address: "With charity toward all and malice toward none." Lincoln spoke these words as the country was coming out of a horrendous civil war. How much different would our divided country look today if we all took holy vows to behave in the way that Augustine and Lincoln encouraged? As part of your ongoing faith formation, why not give it a try yourself? The country needs it.
