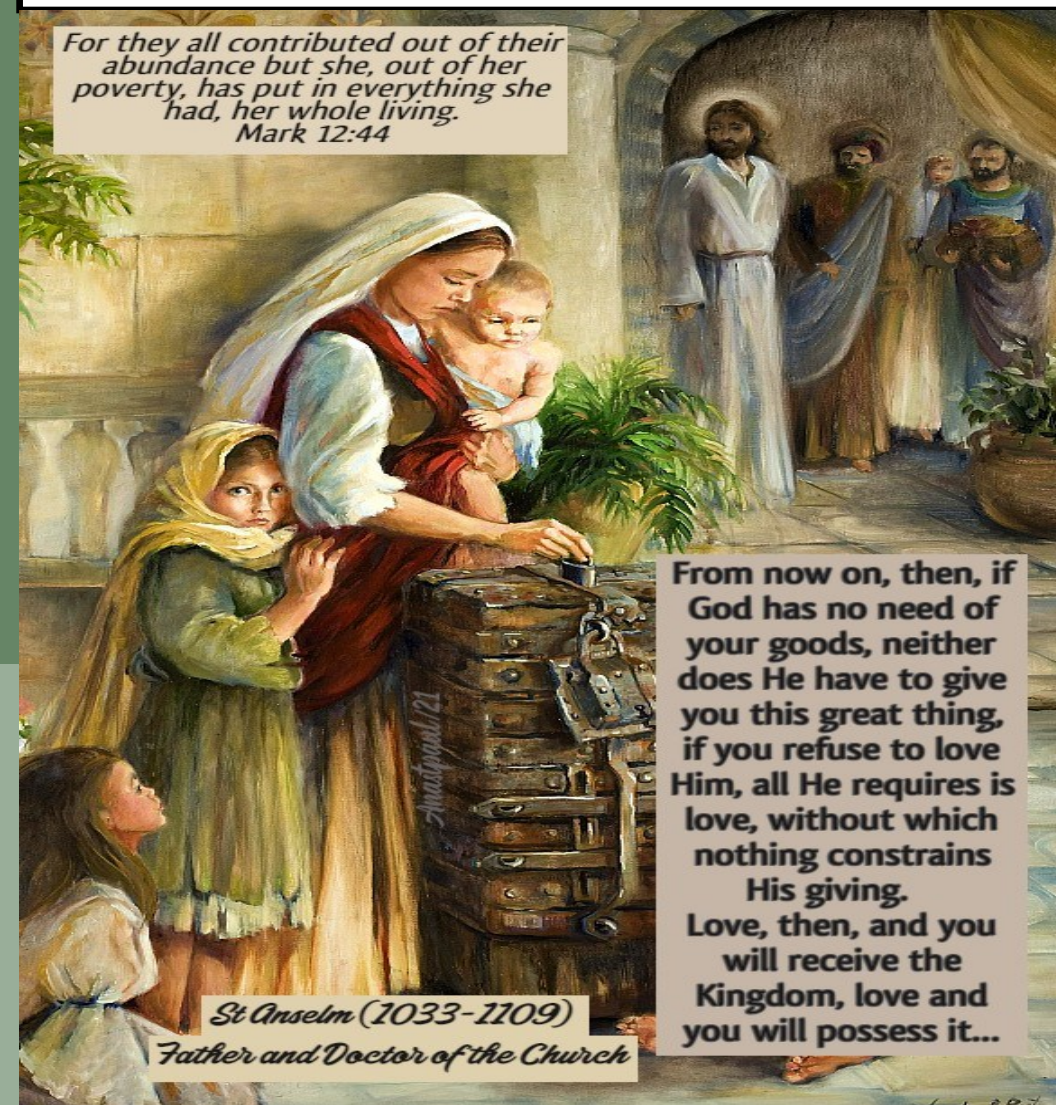

### Fr. Louis' Corner



I believe that this Gospel story can help us to understand the need for the synod that we have begun in the Church. Synodality roughly means "common road" we journey together; and to journey together we must listen to each other, not as if we were in a congress trying to convince our opponents to come over to our side, rather as people listening to the Holy Spirit through and with each other. Otherwise Church leaders can fall into the same trap that the scribes do in our Gospel story today. Jesus really lets the scribes have it in his warning to the people. They like their places of honor and their ceremonial robes that cause people to show them deference in public. I can see that there is a strong warning for me in this. Even in this time of trouble and upheaval in our Church people still love their priests, and they want to show them respect and do nice things for them. This is a good thing. I do not think that Jesus is telling us that there is anything wrong with being honored by someone or that displaying symbols that can show our importance is wrong in itself. There is a danger spiritually, however. We can let these things go to our heads. We can come to believe that we are entitled to these benefits. It becomes problematic when we take advantage of these symbols for earthly gain.



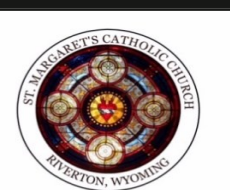

He was so paranoid that he had a servant whose sole job was to monitor his teabags. Riches didn't combat the fears of Howard Hughes. He wound up as an emaciated hermit in Mexico. Fame didn't help John Lennon. He was afraid to sleep with the lights off! So - - - once again - - - how do we combat our fears? By believing the promises of Sacred Scripture, which tell us (not coincidentally!) to not be afraid a total of 365 times! One of the best known of those times is Psalm 23: "Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil." Notice the wording: the valley of "The shadow of death."
