



# Second Sunday of Advent

As we continue our Advent journey together the Church directs our focus to St. John the Baptist. In our Gospel reading this week we hear St. Luke's introduction of John's ministry in the desert. As he does with Jesus, Luke emphasizes the exact time in history of John's ministry. This helps us to re-

member that Jesus and John are not legendary figures representing how we should live, rather people who lived at a particular time in history to show us the way to prepare our lives so that we can conform ourselves to the discipleship to which the Lord calls us. Luke then quotes the Prophet Isaiah. This quote appears in all four Gospels as well as in other books of the New Testament. Isaiah tells us to make the way strait for the Lord. Of course we know that the Lord does not need strait roads to get to us He is all powerful and can do anything. He respects our freedom and so the only road blocks, if you will, between us and God exist in our hearts and minds. We must prepare ourselves so that we can allow the Lord's Grace to work in our lives.
