

The Sunday within the Octave of Christmas is the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. This year we hear the Gospel account of the Third Joyful Mystery of the Rosary: the finding of the Boy Jesus in the Temple. Every year Mary and

Joseph faithfully traveled to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover. This was a familiar joyful journey for the family. As we well know when Jesus was twelve; He staved behind at the Temple. Jesus would have made this trip every year of His life and would have earned the trust of His earthly parents over those years. If

On this Sunday of the "Holy Family of Mary and Joseph" I'm thinking about the spirit of giving that permeates much of our world during this time of year. Specifically, I re-read one of my favorite short stories: O. Henry's "The Gift of the Magi." It's a story that's worth reading and re-reading, especially during the Christmas Season (which began on Wednesday.) It's a story of sacrificial giving. But the very best story about sacrificial giving is the story of the birth, life and death of Jesus the Christ. It's His birth and His family we celebrate today. His gift to us is the greatest gift of all. Think of it: the Creator of universes in a feed trough! This time of year, we leave our gifts under the tree. Jesus left His ON the tree. This is the reason that the baby in the manger came to live among us in the first place.
