The Third Sunday of Ordinary Time is Word of the Lord Sunday. We also celebrate the beginning of the Jubilee year on this Sunday in our diocese. The Word of the Lord should rightly be emphasized every Sunday and indeed every day of our lives. This Sunday in the early part of Ordinary Time we are called to contemplate more deeply on what God's Word means to our lives. We know that Jesus is the Word and so we should pray on how we welcome Jesus into our lives. Of course all of the Bible is the Word of the Lord as well. In our first reading we hear of Ezra reading the Words of the Law to the people. He and the other teachers told the people to be glad for and to celebrate those words. St. Paul tells us that we are all part of the body of Christ, and just as a foot cannot choose to not be part of a body we are part of the body of Christ which means that we are part of His Word. Let us not be an atrophied part of His Word; let us be a truly vibrant part.

To the Women of St. Margaret's Church...

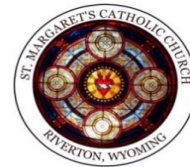

All are welcome to attend the first Jubilee Year Pilgrims of Hope Retreat on Saturday, February 15, 2025, at the Cathedral of Saint Mary, Cheyenne, beginning at 9 am, and closing with Mass at 4 pm. The retreat focuses on hope for those who are sick, elderly, homebound, and hospitalized. The day includes a **Mercy Hour** – Sacrament of Reconciliation and Healing Prayer – open to the public, from 1 pm to 2:30 pm, as well as anointing of the sick, elderly, and infirmed, during Mass. Bishop Steven will open the retreat by discussing hope and the sources of hope: Word of God, Holy Spirit, Paschal Mystery, and Saints of Hope. Participants will join in Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction, engage in the Spiritual Conversation, and explore ways to become witnesses of hope for others. Lunch will be provided. The Diocese of Cheyenne is looking for a way to **possibly** provide simultaneous translation. Faith Formation News

Today, we come back to the truth that while God is in absolute control of all life, God is not the cause of all of life's mishaps. Rather, God's plan allows those mishaps for the great purpose of raising up "many brethren conformed to the image of Christ" (Rom. 8:29). Look at Job's trials! He couldn't understand how God could allow misery to continue; let alone happen. We tend to see things Job's way because we don't understand how God thinks. We can't comprehend the nature of God's wisdom. Isaiah 55:8: "His thoughts are not our thoughts; His ways are not our ways." When we're new in the faith, or immature, or in a time of weakness, we think God will do what is best for us. And God will! But what WE think is best & what God does are as different as different can be: kind of like comparing chocolate sauce and asphalt.
