All are welcome to attend the first Jubilee Year Pilgrims of Hope Retreat on Saturday, February 15, 2025, at the Cathedral of Saint Mary, Cheyenne, beginning at 9 am, and closing with Mass at 4 pm. The retreat focuses on hope for those who are sick, elderly, homebound, and hospitalized. The day includes a **Mercy Hour** – Sacrament of Reconciliation and Healing Prayer – open to the public, from 1 pm to 2:30 pm, as well as anointing of the sick, elderly, and infirmed, during Mass. Bishop Steven will open the retreat by discussing hope and the sources of hope: Word of God, Holy Spirit, Paschal Mystery, and Saints of Hope. Participants will join in Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction, engage in the Spiritual Conversation, and explore ways to become witnesses of hope for others. Lunch will be provided. The Diocese of Cheyenne is looking for a way to **possibly** provide simultaneous translation. Faith Formation News

Today we commemorate the presentation of the Lord. Today is also known by another name: "Candlemas." It is a traditional Christian festival, dating back nearly 1400 years! It commemorates the ritual purification of Mary, 40 days after the birth of her son Jesus. It also marks the ritual presentation of baby Jesus to God in the temple at Jerusalem. Candlemas Day also has other names. One is the "Presentation of Christ in the Temple," which we consecrate today. The Christ is the light who came into this world to dispel sin and darkness. For this reason, traditionally at least since the seventh century, candles have been blessed at Mass this day that will be used throughout the year in Christian homes, hence coining the term "Candlemas." Make sure your ongoing faith formation includes "Candlemas," another fabulous tradition of the Church.
