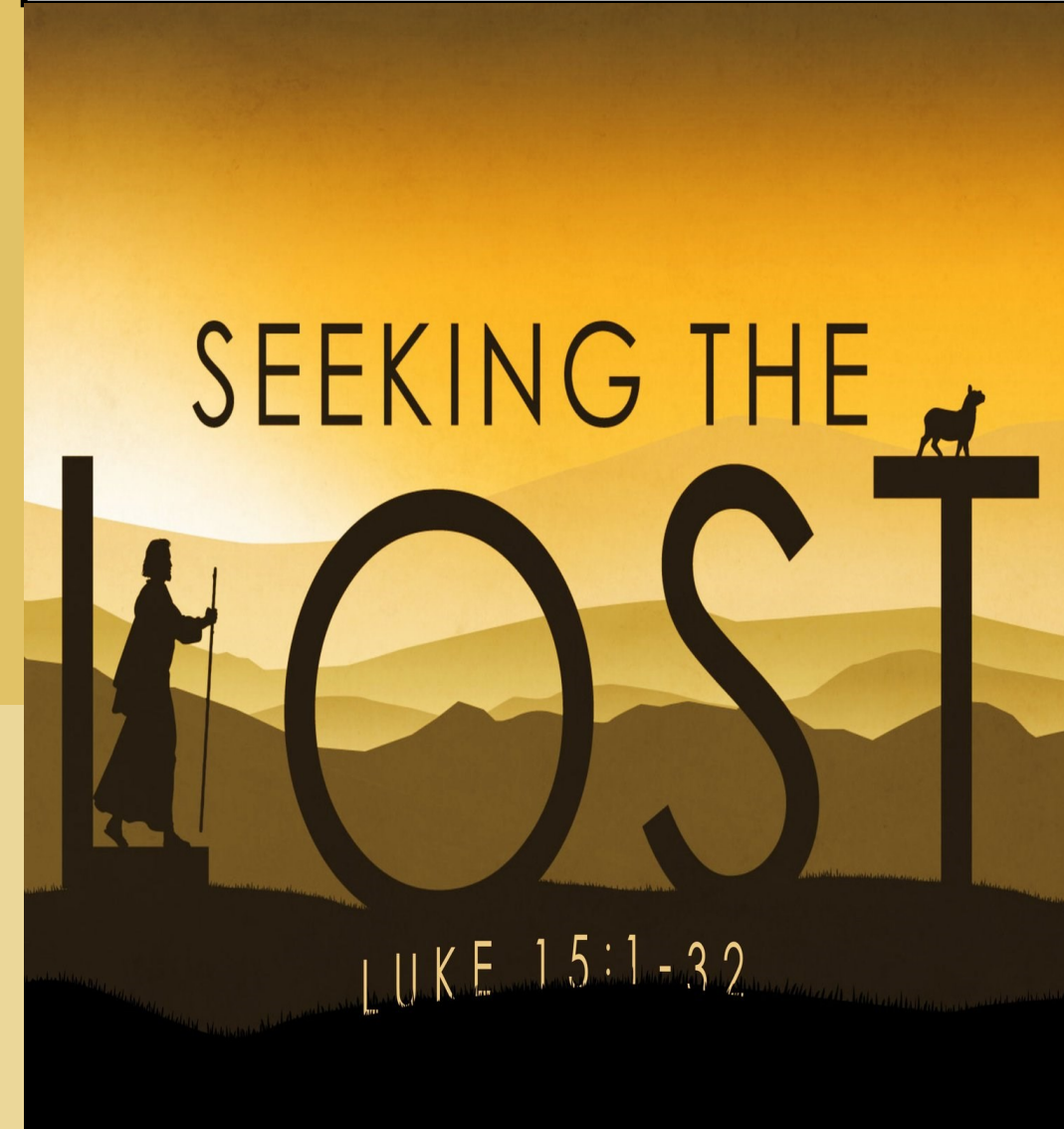

Laetare! Let us truly rejoice as we celebrate the fourth Sunday of Lent: Laetare Sunday. We will also celebrate the second Scrutiny at our Saturday Mass. So once again we have two different sets of readings for our Masses. Our Gospel reading from St Luke's Gospel is very well known: the parable of the prodigal son. The Gospel reading from St John's Gospel is the healing of the man born blind which is also quite well known. In this reading the disciples ask Jesus whose sin caused the man to be born blind. It was a commonly held belief in Jesus' time that blindness was a punishment from God. Jesus tells His disciples that it is neither and that the man was born blind "so that the works of God may be made visible through him." We can see that this is the answer to all of the suffering in the world, when people suffer and Children of God help them we know that the works of God are revealed. We can see that the prodigal son and his brother are blind to the goodness of his father. The father allows the Love of God to work through him as he shows enduring love for his sons. Will the older son come to understand this as the younger son did?

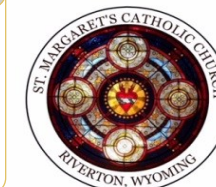
