Fr. Louis' Corner

Our Palm Sunday liturgy is indeed rich with the Word of God. We begin before Mass with either the Procession or the Solemn Entrance. We bless the palms and hear of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Things look bleak when we read the Passion play together. We know that these are the processes that lead to our salvation. Doubts and fears seem to always come along with faith; they are integral parts of the process. As most of you know we had our clergy institute this last week and we spent the time delving into Catholic Social Teaching, which is

based on three principles, the first of which is the dignity of the human person. As catholics we are called to respect that dignity even, and maybe most especially, when a person seems to be tray that dignity through their actions; some people make it hard to recognize their dignity. The Jewish leaders have a hard time recognizing and respecting Jesus' dignity in Christ's passion and He dies a very undignified death. But His dignity remained and we Catholics, indeed all Christians, can recognize our Lord's dignity in His suffering. Let us endeavor to recognize and respect the dignity of every person, if for no other reason, because Jesus wants us to.

Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy (Diary, 699).

There are at least 4 important things for us to take from this Palm Sunday. (1) It was **Faith Formation News** carefully planned. It was no sudden, impulsive action. Jesus had his arrangement with the owners of the colt. (2) It was an act of glorious defiance and superlative courage. Why? There was a price on Jesus' head! (John 11: 57.) Anyone else would have been "on the lam!" (3) The method of Jesus' entry was a deliberate claim to be king, a fulfilling of the picture in Zechariah.9:9. (4) It was one last appeal. Jesus came with pleading hands outstretched, saving, "Even now, will you not take me as your king?" Before the hatred of men engulfed him, once again he confronted them with love's invitation. He makes that same invitation of love to us today. Don't belong to the crowd that yelled "Crucify Him!" on Good Friday. Instead, endeavor to belong to the Palm Sunday crowd and sing "Hosannal"
