Faith Formation News

Chapter 3 of the First Letter of St. John is incredible. It tells us so much in just a short space. Verse 1 tells us who we are: members of God's family. Verse 2 tells us what we are becoming: reflections of God. The rest of chapter 3 tells us what we take with us as we grow to resemble God: victory over sin, love for others, confidence before God. Because Jesus sacrificed Himself for us, we can be forgiven through the Sacraments of the Church. That is cause for rejoicing in heaven. And there are two ways there can be rejoicing in Heaven. Heaven can rejoice "over" you (after all, you are there). And Heaven can rejoice because of you, because of another repenting sinner you brought to salvation in Christ Jesus. Because YOU might be that repenting sinner. Rejoicing in heaven: it can be over you and it can be because of you. But it's up to you.
