

Fr. Eugene's Corner

The art of decision-making is one that demands careful thought and sound judgment. This is because decisions give rise to practices and symbols that shape generations. The early Church was faced with a serious

challenge regarding how Gentiles could be admitted into the Christian community, especially given the prevailing Jewish misconceptions about Gentiles. This led to the need for a robust and Spirit-led decision-making process to resolve the issue. Because of the significance of the matter, the Church recognized the necessity of seeking the guidance of the Holy Spirit. As Christians today, we too are

constantly faced with situations that demand wise and timely decisions. The good news is that the Holy Spirit is always ready and available to assist us in making the right choices. In the Gospel, Jesus promised us the Holy Spirit precisely because He knew our human frailty and limitations. He said, "But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have said to you" (John 14:26). Christ understood our need for divine guidance, and so He sent us the Spirit to be our Advocate and Helper. Practically, just as the early Church sought the help of the Holy Spirit during its first Ecumenical Council (Acts 15), we are also called to seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit whenever we are confronted with decisions—whether big or small. Scripture encourages us in this regard: "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given to him" (James 1:5). This calls us to grow in our awareness of the presence of the Spirit, and to seek Him earnestly through prayer and the study of Scripture.
