

### Annual Principal's Address

Dear St. Margaret's Community,

As we close another beautiful school year, I'm once again filled with immeasurable gratitude for the trust you place in us and the shared mission we embrace in nurturing the minds and souls of these young people. It is a privilege to serve as your principal, and I'm excited to share the progress we've made alongside the vision we're carrying forward into next school year.

WITH ESA, TUITION IS FREE! Last year, we talked about the potential of Education Savings Accounts, and today the dream has become reality. Thanks to this legislation, families can now send their children to St. Margaret's School tuition-free out-ofpocket. This is an incredible blessing and a true answer to prayer, but new families must act quickly, as funds are limited. If you or someone you know is considering Catholic education, now is the time! Assessment and Academic Progress: This time last year, we were working to instrduce WYTOPP - the state standardized test - and to implement stronger practices in using Fast Bridge data in order to better understand and support student learning. Fast Bridge remains a powerful tool to help us "look ahead," showing how well students are positioned to access grade-level content. We've come a long way already; our teacher team interprets and applies data insights to guide instruction. These assessments not only reflect student learning but also validate our commitment to academic excellence and are a critical part of our accreditation journey. Our instructional practices will only become stronger as we continue aligning our curriculum from preschool through grade 5.


Curriculum Advancements: Our teaching team has continued their incredible work in developing a guaranteed and viable curriculum. This year, their focus has been math - identifying priority standards by grade level, designing a PreK-5th grade skill progression. Now they move on to I) crafting meaningful assessments that measure mastery, ensure long-term retention, and strengthen our commitment to lifelong learning, and 2) aligning these learning targets to our instructional resource (i-Ready), our multisensory instructional approach, and our Catholic identity. After they complete this work with Math, they start over with Language Arts. This process will likely take the next two school years.

Accreditation Journey: This fall, we continue the rigorous accreditation process through the Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA). Accreditation is a powerful reflection of who we are. It affirms that our Catholic identity, academic programming, and commitment to growth meet the highest standards. While the process is demanding, it's also deeply rewarding and perfectly aligned with the progress we've made over the last few years. We are ready.

School Safety and Facilities: Last summer brought a flurry of construction through our Nonprofit Security Grant, and I'm proud to share that those projects are near complete. Additional safety initiatives, funded through generous donations and fundraising efforts, are also complete. Most recently, our parish now owns the alley adjacent to the school. This summer, we'll begin repairing the road and planning for gated access at both ends. It will be a marathon, not a sprint, as we want to be intentional in both planning and funding, but it marks a significant step forward in ensuring the safety and security of our students.



The Ascension of Jesus Christ into heaven is a gift to Christians. The Fr. Eugene's Corner readings of today remind us of Jesus Christ's promise to send the Holy Spirit to His disciples, empowering them to bear fruit that will last. The Ascension is the glorification of the life, suffering, and resurrection of Christ.

The purpose of the Ascension of Christ is to affirm our faith that we shall rise again with Jesus. It proves to us that there is a heaven, and we have a home in heaven where God dwells. It also shows us that God is interested in receiving us when we all get to heaven.

We are called upon to reflect on the Ascension and its impact on our Christian faith. As written in John 6:62, Jesus asks, "What if you see the Son of Man ascending to where He was before?" This statement challenges us to understand the significance of His divine nature and the promise of eternal life.

In Acts 1:9-11 states, "After He said this, He was taken up before their very eves, and a cloud hid Him from their sight... this same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven." This passage reassures us of Christ's promise to return.

May the Word of God bear fruit in us through Christ our Lord.


