



I was originally trained as an historian, before I attended and graduated from seminary. I achieved an MA in history from Arizona State University and was a teaching assistant in the history department there. I look at things with an historical eye. It is my belief that this country is more divided now than at any time since the Civil War. And look what that cost us. Nearly ¾ million casualties. That's equivalent to more than 20 million today. This nation is absolutely polarized, with little if any middle ground. I believe that we need solid, moral people to stand in the gap and plant some seeds of peace and unity. That's what Jesus prayed for in the garden: that we all be as one as He and the Father are one. So please carry this thought with you. Never underestimate the power of a seed. Jesus certainly didn't.


