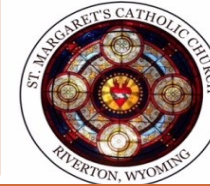

Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, celebrates in a special way the mystery that is so important to our faith. Indeed we celebrate the most holy body and blood of Jesus at every Mass and every time we take part in Eucharistic adoration. We know that it is the source and summit of our faith. It is a blessed gift that the Lord has given to us through the apostles at the last supper. We hear St Paul tell of this in his First Letter to the Corinthians. The priests break the bread that Jesus has entered through the power of the Holy Spirit and gives it to the people. It is the bread that lasts. We are truly fed by it. We hear in the Sequence that Jesus refreshes us with this bread. He sends us to the land of life. We hear of the feeding of the five thousand in our Gospel reading this week. Jesus takes the bread, breaks and blesses it and gives it to the people. This helps us to remember that we are called to share and help as Jesus always did.

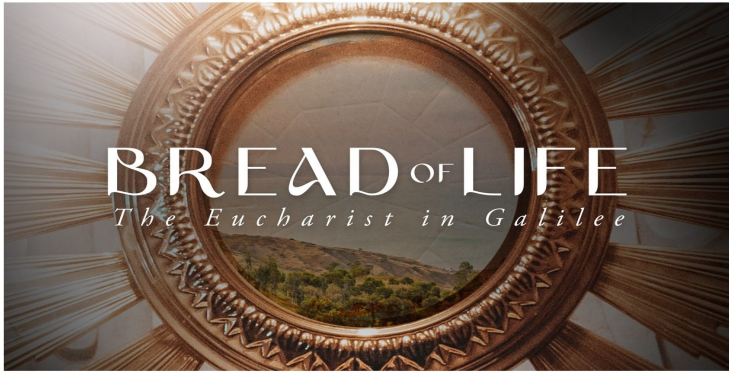

I was originally trained as an historian, before I attended and graduated from seminary. I achieved an MA in history from Arizona State University and was a teaching assistant in the history department there. I look at things with an historical eye. It is my belief that this country is more divided now than at any time since the Civil War. And look what that cost us. Nearly ¾ million casualties. That’s equivalent to more than 20 million today. This nation is absolutely polarized, with little if any middle ground. I believe that we need solid, moral people to stand in the gap and plant some seeds of peace and unity. That’s what Jesus prayed for in the garden: that we all be as one as He and the Father are one. So please carry this thought with you. Never underestimate the power of a seed. Jesus certainly didn’t.
