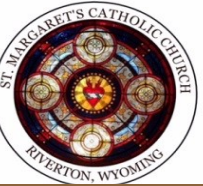

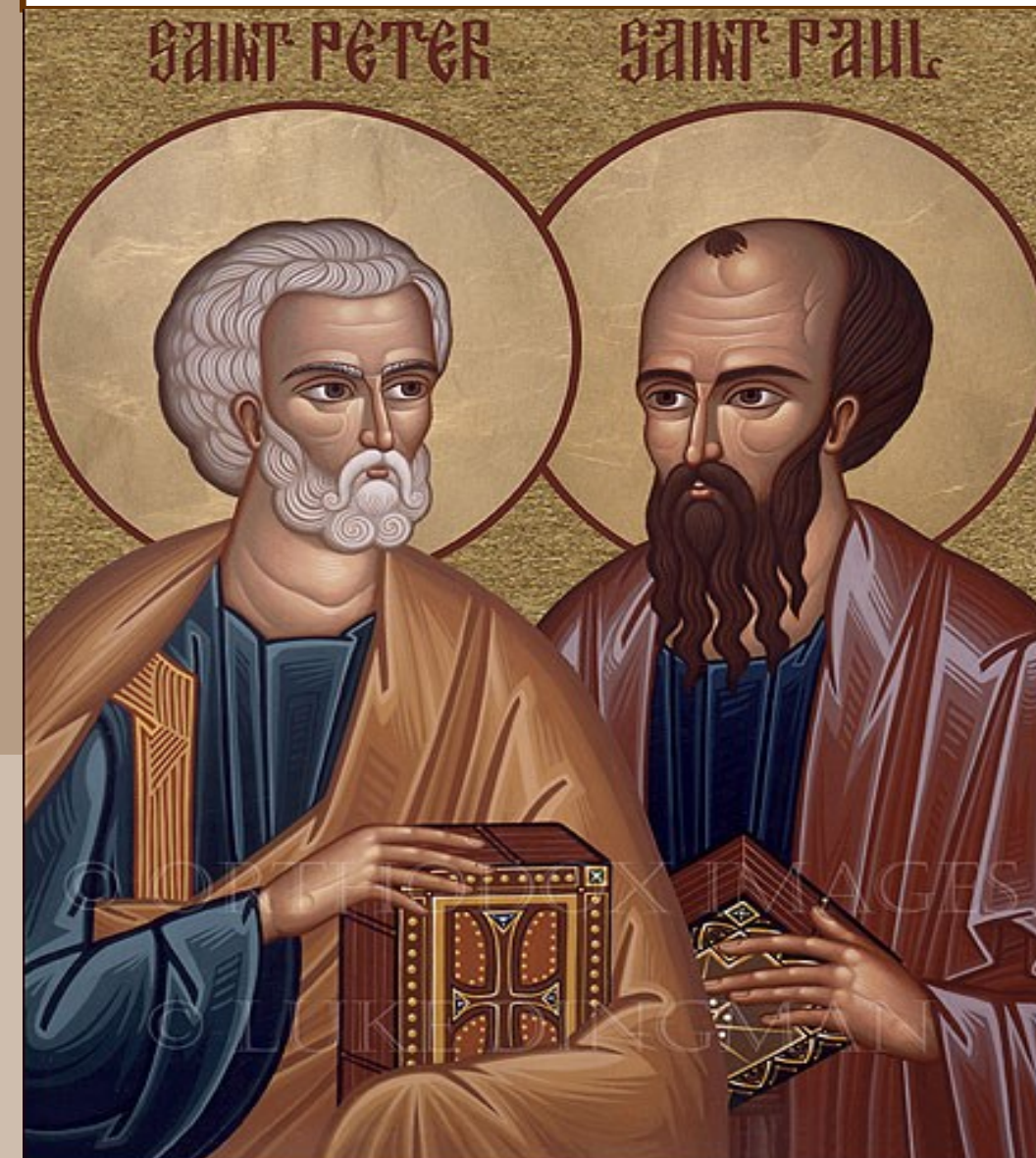

Faith Formation News

This week’s Faith Formation blurb is a follow-up to last week. Protests have turned violent. We have the right to assemble, but not the right to loot and destroy. Where’s the middle ground? What we call news becomes editorial vs news reporting. Where’s the middle ground? What we have here is an inverted bell curve. In a normal bell curve, the “fat part” of the curve is in the middle. That’s where things get done. But now, the “fat parts” of the bell curve are out on the edges, and the middle is where the ice is the thinnest. This country needs strong, moral Christians to stand on that thin ice and plant seeds of peace and unity. That’s what the Apostles did, offering peace and unity through the triune God. As successors to the Apostles, that’s what we need to do. Plant seeds of peace and unity. Never underestimate the power of a seed.
