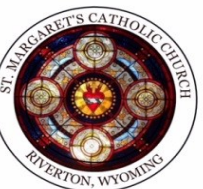

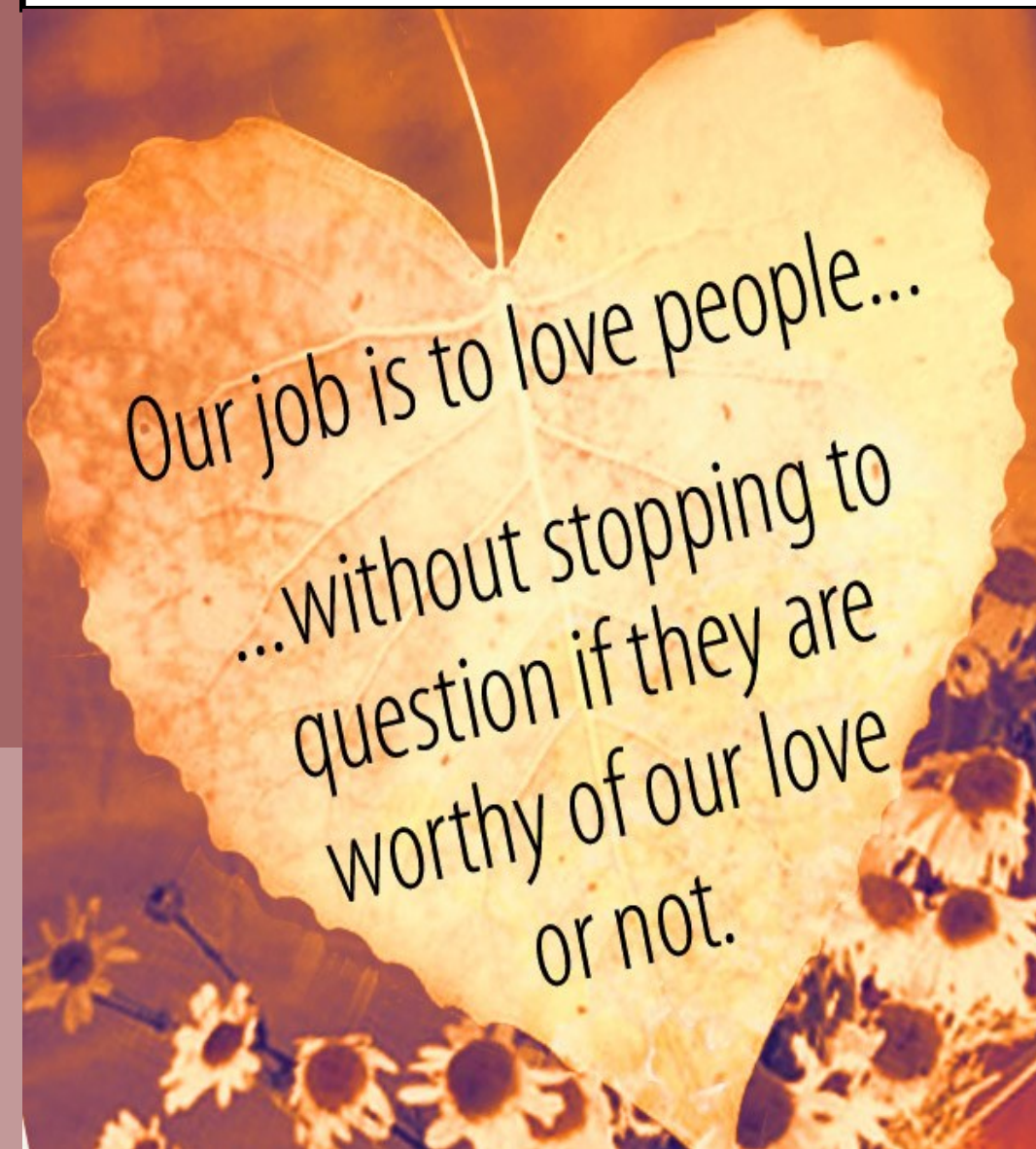

Fr. Louis’ Corner

We are fed by the story of the Good Samaritan at our Mass this weekend. The lead in to the parable is quite interesting and very important to the story. A teacher of the law, a scribe, asks Jesus a question about what he must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus turns the question back on him and he responds with the greatest commandment. Jesus concurs and tells him to do that and he will live. Then the scribe asks Jesus who is his neighbor, so Jesus tells him the parable of the Good Samaritan. Jesus doesn’t actually answer the question as it was asked, this scholar actually is asking who qualifies to be treated as a neighbor. This is nuanced teaching; Jesus is teaching us how to be a good neighbor with this story. He is telling us to treat everyone as we would like to be treated. The scribe has to admit that the Samaritan was the one who treated him as his neighbor, however he just said the one who treated him with mercy, apparently not wanting to sully his mouth by uttering the word Samaritan. Jesus simply tells him to go and do likewise. He is telling us that too. Go and treat all with mercy.

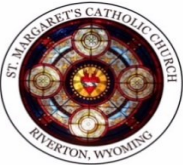
