

Fr. Louis' Corner

Our Gospel passage this week starts with a man in the crowd asking, demanding really depending on how you read it, Jesus to tell his brother to share the inheritance with him. Jesus does not get drawn into this family disagreement, but rather uses this as a teaching opportunity. He tells us not to be greedy. It would seem that neither brother

here is really considering what God would want him to do. We do not know which one is in the wrong, but it seems they probably both are. Jesus goes on to tell the parable of the rich fool. This man is only concerned about himself. He plans on ways to hoard his rich harvest and thinks not one bit about helping the poor. Deeper than that though he does not even give a thought to thanking God for the bounty of the harvest, rather congratulates himself and revels over how wonderful his life will be. He soon finds out that without God his life is temporary. Let us not fall into this trap. Let us keep God first and not let greed take us over.
