

Fr. Louis' Corner

In our Gospel reading this Sunday we hear Jesus say that if salt loses its flavor, it is good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot: here in Wyoming, we know that having salt underfoot can be quite a blessing especially this time of year. Seriously though, He is using the imagery of salt that was so important as a preservative in His time, as well as flavoring, to tell His disciples how important their ministry will be for the world. He moves on to tell them not to hide their light; the light of Christ that they are to reflect in their lives. We must let our light shine in this world so that we, as Christian disciples, can be a shining example to everyone. As part of the Sermon on the Mount this reading follows immediately after the beatitudes so that we can know how to be the salt and light of the Good News of Jesus Christ.

I'm drawn today to the 16th Chapter of Matthew. This is where Jesus asks "who do you say that I am?" And Peter answers by acknowledging Jesus as the Messiah. Jesus then responds to Peter by telling him that "you are Petros, and upon this Petra I will build my church." This is where digging into the original Greek language can really help us to relate to this verse. "Petros" is a rock, a boulder, or a single stone. "Petra" is bedrock, or a cliff of many stones. You might say that the Church is "Petros"; the rock upon which we place our faith. It might also be said that we, as members of the Church, comprise "Petra," a cliff of many stones. The Church is comprised of a "cloud of witnesses" as Paul put it. Are you a member of that cloud? And back to the word "Petra" - - - are you one of the stones in that cliff upon which Christ builds His church?
