Fr. Louis' Corner

Now we find ourselves in the second half of Lent. This Sunday many of our parishes are celebrating the Third Scrutiny. Our Gospel reading is about the raising of Lazarus from the dead. When Jesus hears the news from Bethany that Lazarus is ill; he waits two days before departing for Bethany. The disciples question Him about His decision to go; they must have thought He didn't leave immediately for fear of the Jewish leaders that had tried to stone Him when last He was there. He tells them that these things have happened to show the power of God. He also tells them that they should come with Him because they will be lost without His light. When Jesus nears Bethany Martha comes to greet Him. She shows great faith in Jesus, but we can see that she only partially understands His power. He calls Lazarus out of the tomb. Lazarus emerges from the tomb with the burial cloths draped off him. When those who have come to support Mary and Martha in their mourning see what Jesus has done many begin to believe. These three weeks of Scrutinies have taught us much about conversion. Let us give thanks for that and continue to pray for those who are to receive Sacrament this Easter!

They enrich me and provide strength, wisdom, and a connecting link to God's presence in many divine ways. I encourage you to examine these four facets of faith for yourselves. (1) Faith as assensus – belief, content, head stuff ... reason. (2) Faith as fiducia - trust ... trusting in God as we live and move and daily live out our being (with God) (3) Faith as fidelity -- faithfulness to our relationship with God ... commitment of self and action at the deep and true level. (4) Faith as vision -- a way of seeing ... how we see life, God, God's world and persons ... and this shapes our responses. May you all experience as many of these four facets as you can - - - today and every day
