Fr. Louis' Corner

Palm Sunday is one of my favorite Masses to celebrate, because I get to give two homilies! We have the Gospel reading at the beginning of the procession. It is about the triumphant Jesus riding into Jerusalem on a donkey. He rides the donkey because it shows that he is a king that is coming in peace. We celebrate that entry with great joy just after we bless the palms. Then during the Mass at the usual time, we read the passion play. This is a much more somber time as we are confronted with the reality that Jesus is about to die for our sins. This should also bring us joy because even though all of these terrible things are about to happen to Jesus, this is how Jesus saves us. So we begin our holy week with joy for what Jesus has done for us, even as we know that our sinfulness has caused Him such terrible suffering.

Faith Formation News

Today we commemorate Jesus entering Jerusalem. A careful study of Sacred Scripture tells us 4 important things about this entrance: (1) It was carefully planned. It was no sudden, impulsive action. (2) It was an act of glorious defiance and superlative courage. Why? There was a price on Jesus' head! (John.11:57.) (3) It was a deliberate claim to be king, a deliberate fulfilling of Zechariah 9:9. That's how the crowd treated him. "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord." (4) It was one last appeal. Jesus came with hands outstretched, implying "Even now, will you not take me as your king?" Before hatred engulfed Him, He once again confronted Jerusalem with love's invitation. But the crowds on Palm Sunday and the crowds on Good Friday were the same people! This is the kind of u-turn we DON'T want to make!
