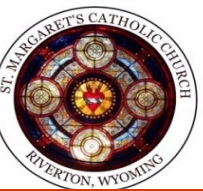

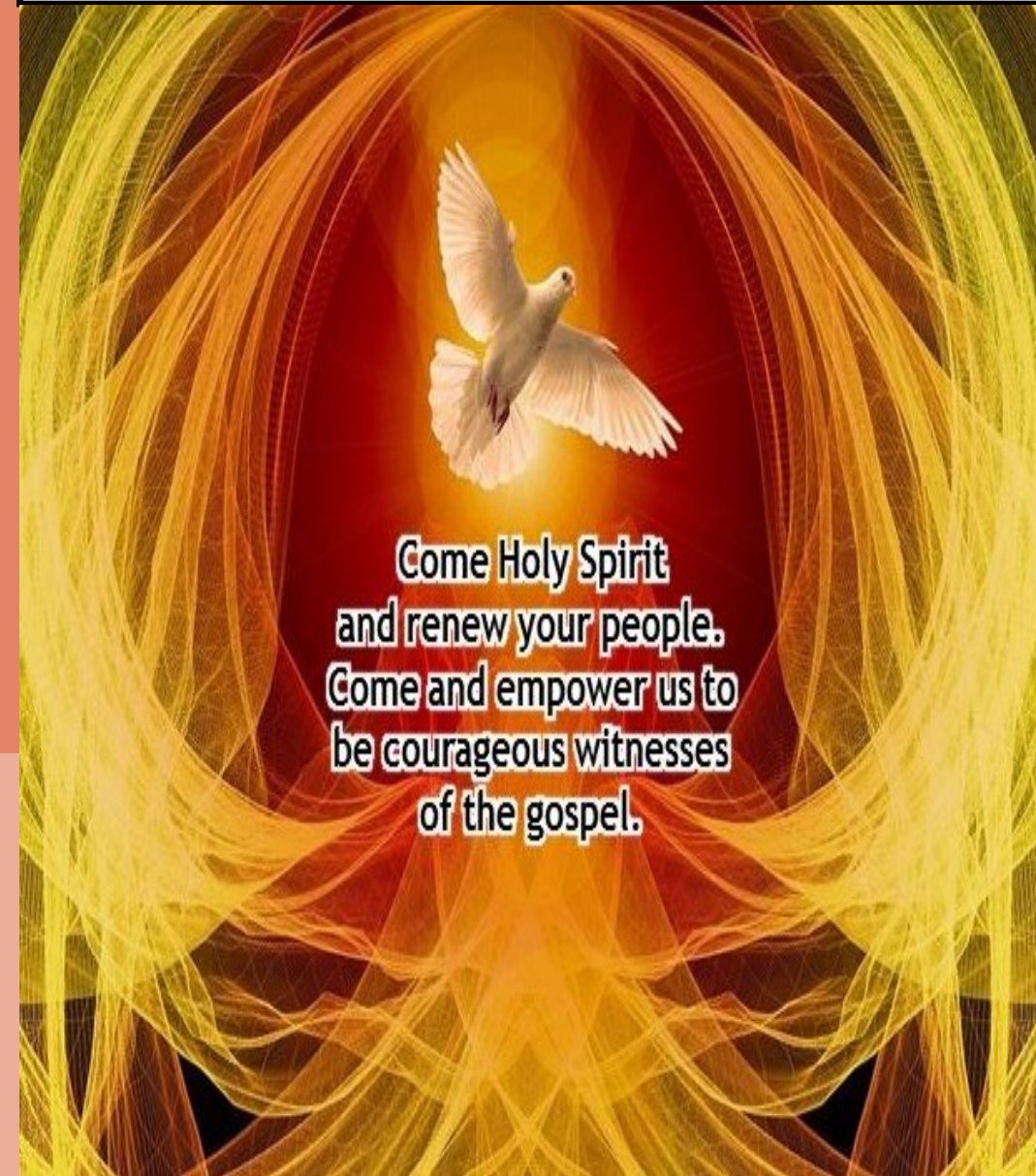

Come, Holy Spirit, come. This is one of my favorite prayers! And it is the beginning of our Pentecost sequence. As you may know I tend to like the sequences. They are traditional homilies that can help us to understand, but more importantly delve into the mysteries of our faith. We know that the workings of the Holy Spirit are mysterious. ### Faith Formation News

Today we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit, and in a way, the birthday of the Church. Regarding the Holy Spirit, one of the greatest errors we can make is to deny the person-hood of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is a person, and not a force or an influence. Sacred Scripture speaks of the mind (Rom 8:27) and the will (1 Cor 12:11) of the Holy Spirit. In multiple places, Scripture also tells us about the deity of the Holy Spirit (Ps 139:7 + Heb 9:14 + Acts 5:3,4). The Holy Spirit also works in salvation (Titus 3:5). The Holy Spirit convicts (Jn 16:7,11) and also works in regenerating us (Jn 3:3,7). Finally, the Holy Spirit has a role in Christian living by indwelling the believer (Eph 3:16-20) by filling us (Eph 5:18) sanctifying us (2 Thess 2:13) producing fruit (Gal 5:22-23) and by teaching us (Jn 14:26). Praise God for this marvelous gift!
