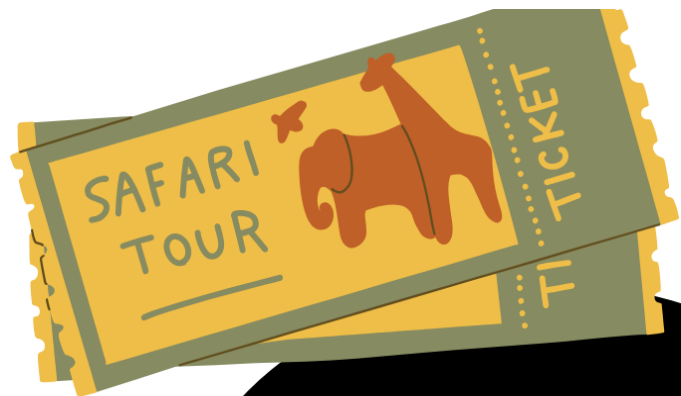

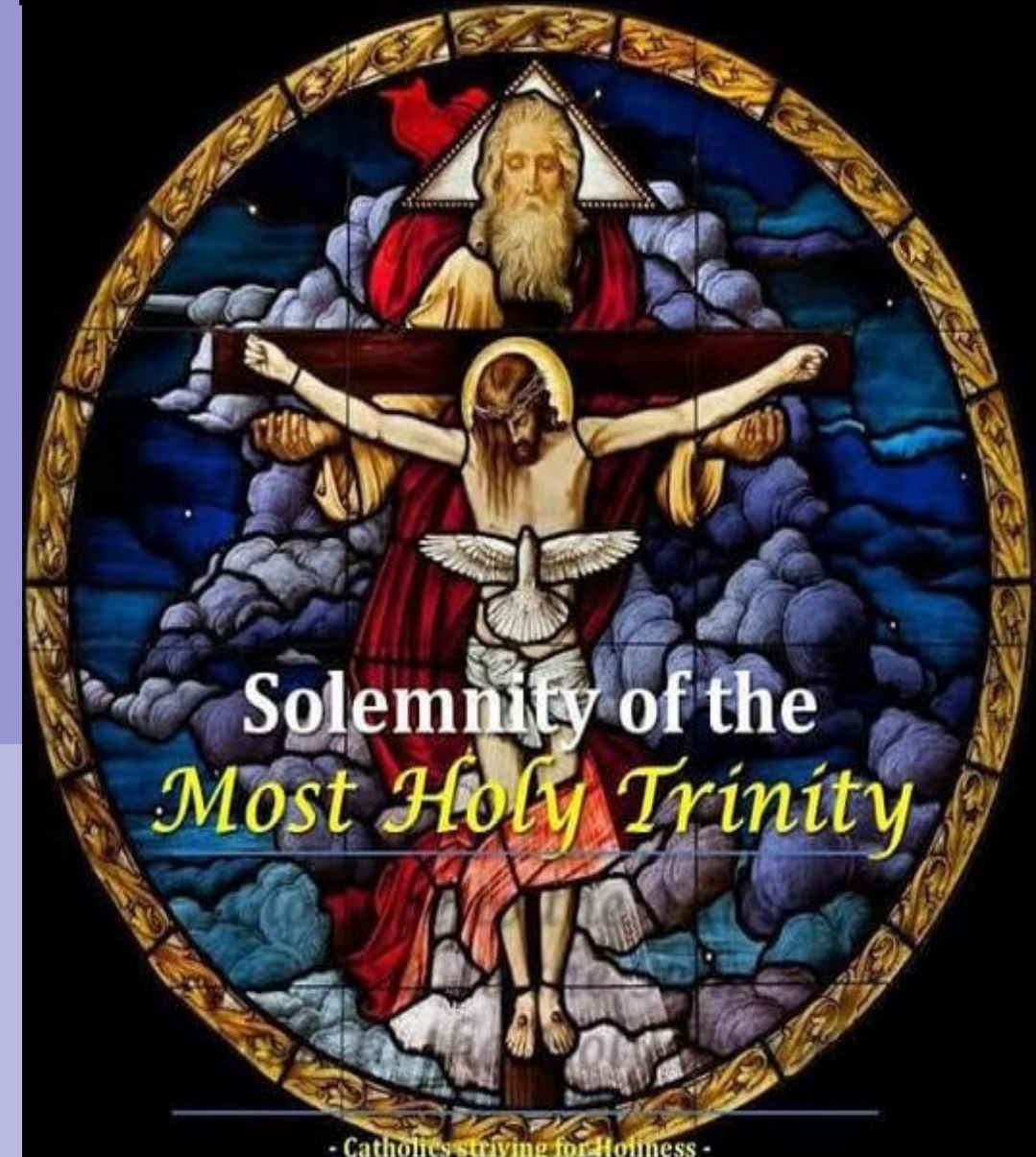

Fr. Louis' Corner

Today we celebrate Holy Trinity Sunday. Three persons in one God. This is a simple concept to believe in, but it is impossible to fully understand. The more you learn about it the more you know how little you actually know. This does not mean that we should not continue to learn and increase our understanding. We should. The most important thing to keep in mind is what God does for us. The Holy Spirit can be understood to be the love that comes from the relationship of the Father and the Son. In our Gospel this week we hear the beautiful declaration from Jesus of the Father's love. The excerpt that we hear is part of a very important teaching of Jesus. In a way our Gospel reading today may not seem like it is about the Trinity since the Holy Spirit is not mentioned. It seems like it is just about the relationship of the Father and the Son, but let us remember that the Holy Spirit is an integral part of that relationship. The Holy Spirit resides in our hearts so that we can share in the divine relationship. Jesus tells us that we must want to live in the light and that our works should reflect the light and not just expect God's grace to take care of everything for us, we must allow the grace of God to work in us.

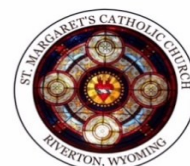

The Most Holy Trinity seems to be a difficult concept for many to wrap their heads around. Dr. Henry Morris can help in that regard. He notes that the entire universe is Trinitarian by design. The universe consists of three things: matter, space, and time. Take away any one of those three and the universe would cease to exist. But each one of those is itself a trinity. Matter consists of mass + energy + motion. Space is made up of length + height + breadth. And time consists of past + present + future. To this I add: Even atoms are 3 in 1! They contain protons + neutrons + electrons. We are Trinity because we are made of mind, body & spirit (soul). And by the way - - - I believe you don't have a soul. You ARE a soul. You have body and mind. Sacred Scripture is full of descriptions of the Trinity. Sounds like a good Bible study to me!
