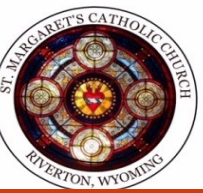

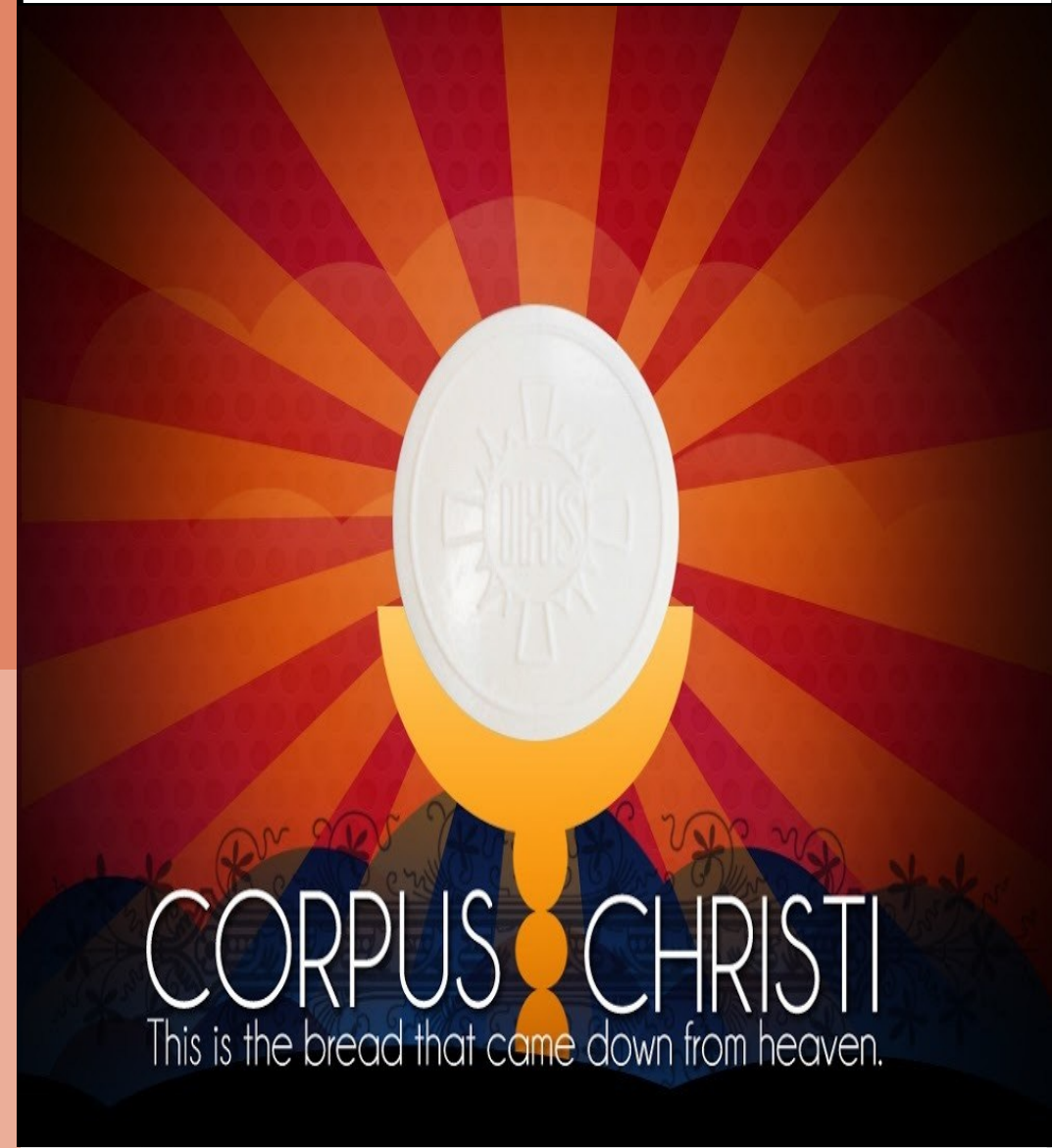

"Lo the angel's food is given, to the pilgrim who has striven.
 " Today we celebrate The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ: Corpus Christi. This quote is from today's sequence. Our Lord and savior Jesus Christ is the bread from heaven. The bread that gives us true life: The life blood of all Christians for all eternity: the Eucharist. At every Mass the gift of Christ on the cross is brought back and given again. Last week we celebrated the mystery of the Holy Trinity, one that we can never truly understand. Now we celebrate the truth of the Eucharist that is quite a bit easier to sink our teeth into, pun intended. Or is it really? In our Gospel reading this week Jesus is appealing to our carnal nature. The word used for eat here is used to describe how animals eat in Greek literature. Yet it is still a beautiful part of the spiritual mystery of our faith. 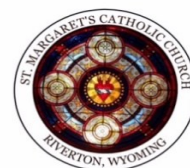

Today is a feast day in which we celebrate the real presence of the Christ in the Sacrament of the Eucharist.
