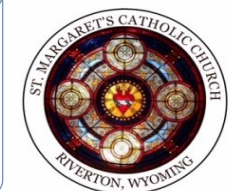

## St. Kateri Tekakwitha: A Story of Devotion to God

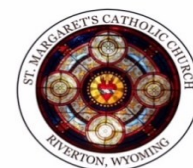
